NMHA Medicare Rx Benefit Materials

The National Mental Health Association has developed tools for local Medicare education including Frequently Asked Questions for beneficiaries and policy leaders, and a consumer-oriented workbook to aid in plan enrollment, and exceptions and appeals. <u>Benefits Check Up Rx</u> is a web-based service by the National Council on Aging and CMS to help individuals apply for a variety of public and private benefit programs that help to lower the cost of prescription drugs, including the Medicare Rx Benefit's Extra Help, Medicaid, and state pharmacy assistance and patient assistance programs.
